Alliance Bank constructs new Williams Centre branch office

Caylor Construction of Tucson has broken ground on a new Williams Centre branch for Alliance Bank of Arizona at 200 S. Craycroft Road. The two-story, 16,300-square-foot granite and glass building, designed by Eglin/Cohen Architects, is scheduled for completion by the second quarter of 2007.

Intended to serve as Alliance Bank's Tucson regional office, the facility will incorporate a regular bank branch, along with an employee training center and the offices of the branch support services group, currently located at Alliance's Swan Road center. In addition, Miller-Russell Wealth Management, another division of the Las Vegas-based Western Alliance Bancorp, will be moving from the Swan branch to offices in the Williams Centre building.

An additional 8,000 square feet of office space will be available for lease, said spokes-

man Chad Twitty. "We're hoping for a related financial services company, like a title company, but there's nothing to announce, yet."
